Credit Card Payments & Fees – Processing and convenience fees will soon apply to credit card payments made to Saw Creek Estates. Previously, the fees have been paid out of the operating budget, funded by all members. Following the launch of a new online payment option, the fees will be paid directly by credit card holders.
