



Program overview

This year we will have various games and activities spread throughout the day. The games will reflect the age and ability level for all ages. We will have our younger campers playing independently of our older campers. Counselors will interact with them during play and I will always be nearby both groups. If the older children and our staff are playing a supervised game of football, the younger ones will be near playing an age appropriate game also supervised. Camp will be divided into 8 weekly themes.

Primary Locations in Saw Creek Estates

Camp will be held this summer at the Mill Pond Complex. All of our pool time, sports, nature walks and other camp related activities will be held here for the entire 8 weeks of camp.

Good Camp Experience Tips

Your camper should come prepared to play, bring a snack along with a packed lunch and beverage. We can refrigerate it if needed.

It is suggested that you pack the following items:

- Sunscreen
- Bug Repellent
- Bathing suit
- Towel (with your initials written on it)
- Snack
- Change of clothes on damp mornings
- Goggles
- Juice/Water
- Jackets (when necessary)
- Sneakers are needed during nature activities week

When packing your bag for camp roll your bathing suit, goggles, sunscreen, water shoes inside your towel. Lunch and snacks should remain in your book bag. Towels and other items need to be kept separately from lunch items. We will assist you. Please remind your camper to keep their items together neatly at the end of each day, especially after pool time. Also, electronic games will not be allowed at camp but they should feel free to bring their phone if they have one. Campers will be busy from the moment they arrive to camp.

Health Form Procedures

Allergies, scrapes and minor injuries (sprains, aches, etc.) will be handled by our staff. The appropriate health forms will be filled out after treatment.

When do we contact parents

I will contact you if there is a disciplinary issue with your child/children. You will also be immediately notified if there is an emergency with your child. I'm hoping this will not occur. We are striving for safety and fair play.

Lost and Found

Unclaimed items will be turned into the Member Services Office after one week, unless it needs refrigeration. Then it will be held until the next day.

Daily Drop-off Logistics

Drop off your camper(s) by 8:30 am for camp. The campers have to be signed in/out daily.
